

Approach route to gate 18 and procedure for car park 11

Car park 11, or P11, is the loading and unloading area near gates 18 and 19. Gate 18 is used primarily for loading and unloading of materials for the conference centre, the Expo Foyer and the Brightlands Foyer. Follow the procedure below to get to P11.

Procedure:

- Enter the site via the barrier at Duboisdomein 5;
- Take a parking ticket at the barrier;
- Continue straight on and follow the route to P10 (past the container area; see drawing), drive past gates 15 and 16 located on your left;
- Near the Expo Foyer, you will see a high and a low barrier column. Hold your parking ticket up to the scanner here. If no more than half an hour has transpired between passing the first barrier and arriving at the second, then the barrier to P11 will open automatically.
- If more than half an hour has passed, press the button on the barrier column. A staff member in the control room or reception will open the barrier manually;
- You can only exit via the barrier at gate 19 (see drawing), which opens automatically. You will not be charged parking fees.

Parking during loading and unloading

To ensure things flow smoothly, we ask freight traffic to turn right after entering P11 and park with the front of the vehicle facing P10 (see map on the next page). This allows everyone to load and unload without blocking one another.

No entrance at gate 19 barrier

The barrier at gate 19 is an exit only and not an entrance. Given the traffic situation on the parallel road (Johan Willem Beyenlaan), it is not possible to enter via gate 19. For this reason, suppliers are redirected to the barrier at P10 in Duboisdomein 5.
